主讲嘉宾简介: John Flower is Founder and Executive Director of the China Folk House, a site for experiential learning, environmental sustainability and people-to-people cultural exchange. He recently retired as Director of the Sidwell Friends School Chinese Studies Program, and is a former Associate Professor of East Asian History at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte and Fellow at the East Asia Center at the University of Virginia. His scholarship includes publications on local history and folklife in China and Tibet. In addition to teaching courses on China and East Asian History and

activities at China Folk House focusing on traditional agriculture, folkways and craft, Dr. Flower leads the "China Fieldwork" experiential learning programs in northwest Yunnan.

Abstract: "Two Sides of a Bridge" presents case studies of "ExEd" [experiential education] that combine language study, place-based learning, hands-on activities, and people-to-people exchange in ways that give students a deeper sense of connection between language, culture, and daily experience. Projects from the China Folk House in West Virginia, and from the CFH 2024 summer program in Yunnan will provide some examples and lessons learned.

特邀讲员简介: Dr. Maan Broadstock dedicated seven years to teaching ninth and twelfth-grade Chinese at the Dayton Regional STEM School (DRSS) in Dayton, Ohio, before retiring in July. Recognizing her exceptional work, she was named the 2024 Ohio Teacher of the Year by the Ohio Foreign Languages Association (OFLA). Her journey into Chinese education began at the Dayton Chinese Weekend School, where she taught for ten years while her sons attended. During this time, her passion for teaching Chinese grew, leading her to pursue various trainings to become a certified

Chinese teacher. In 2006, Dr. Broadstock established the Chinese program at Centerville High School, where she taught Chinese levels 1-4 and AP Chinese. Before joining DRSS in 2017, she was a Chinese instructor at Wright State University for four years. At DRSS, Dr. Broadstock embraced the collaborative environment and enjoyed integrating project-based learning into her teaching. Her greatest joy comes from seeing her students' enthusiasm for learning Chinese and watching them grow into lifelong learners.

Abstract: In this session, we will explore the distinction between traditional projects and Project-Based Learning (PBL) while examining the rationale, design, and implementation of a Chinese 1 PBL project in Dayton Regional STEM School (DRSS). Through a real-world project, participants will gain insight into the PBL essential elements that make PBL effective. Additionally, we'll showcase interdisciplinary PBL projects which created a dynamic, immersive environment for students to enhance their language skills and cultural awareness. By the end of the session, join us to discuss the benefits and challenges of PBL and discover how it can enrich your language classroom!

特邀讲员简介: Betty McGinnis is the Founder and President of World Artists Experiences, a non-profit organization to bridge people and cultures around the world for international understanding using the arts in communities, colleges and schools. The organization develops ambassador series of world experiences in communities, international education opportunities, cultural immersion experiences, and sustainable development projects. Previously, she taught at the University of Maryland and

worked with the Maryland State Department of Education on international projects and educational opportunities for teachers and those visiting Maryland, and acted as a consultant on bridging the people and cultures of the world. She developed international partnerships, youth conferences for youth from over 125 countries, developed and led numerous tour experiences for all ages to learn with and from the people of the world, and led sustainable development projects. As well, Betty served on numerous boards, including Life and Peace Institute, Refugee Resettlement Centers, Czech Partners Together, Synod of the Mid-Atlantic. She has worked with numerous countries' Ministries of Culture and Education around the world and Embassies. Betty enjoys her family with her husband, children and grandchildren and hosting friends from around the world in their home.

Abstract: By experiencing culture, dialogue is fostered. Key ingredients are necessary. Through my experiences in development of bridging culture and people across the world, setting values, goals and partnerships are essential. Mutual understanding is the goal. Culture sets a stage for educational opportunities. An outcome of these opportunities leads to citizen diplomats. These are steps toward respect, trust and thus peace in our world.


中学生参加汉语桥的暑期游学项目。张宽老师将分享他暑期组团赴华游学的经验和体会。
